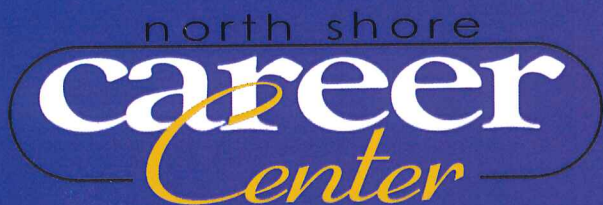


Our Mission Statement
