


Careers in Health Care

Associates Degree + BLS Certification \rightarrow Clinical Laboratory Technicians \rightarrow Bachelor's Degree \rightarrow Clinical Laboratory Technologists

Medical Assistant

Post-Secondary Award + BLS Certification → on-the-job training → Dental Assistants
