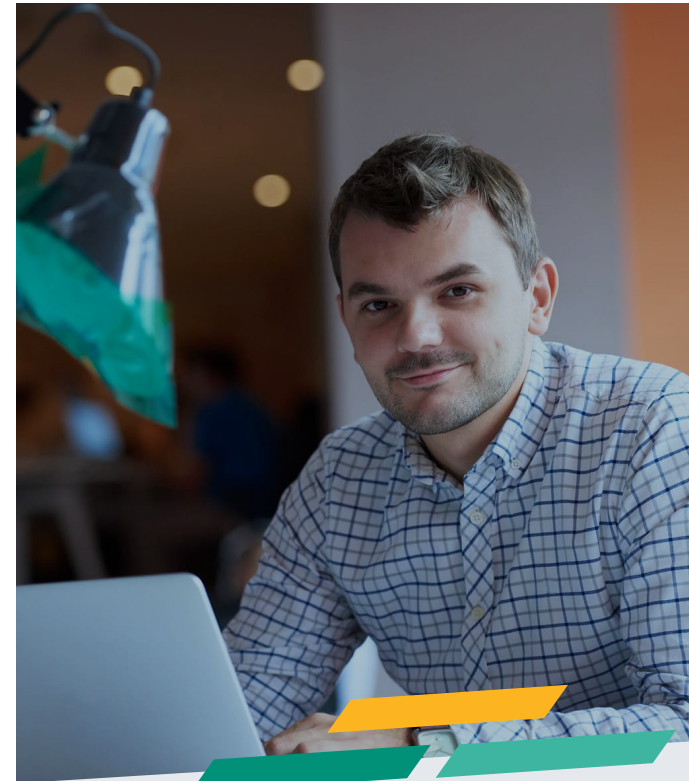

## Sustainable Energy Pre-Apprenticeship Trades Training
