- There were 512,904 total UI claimants in Massachusetts as of 5/2/2020
 - 6.9% of all MA UI claimants reside on the North Shore
- Priority industries account for 25% of Massachusetts and 23% of North Shore total UI claimants
- Critical industries account for 13% of Massachusetts and 12% of North Shore total UI claimants
- Industries with a significant number of UI Claims (not including Priority & Critical):
 - Accommodation and Food Services – 20% MA, 20% of North Shore UI Claimants
 - Retail Trade – 14% MA, 16% of North Shore UI Claimants
 - Administrative and Waste Services - 7% MA, 6% of North Shore UI Claimants
 - Transportation and Warehousing - 4% MA, 5% of North Shore UI Claimants
 - Other Services (included in the *All Other Industries* category) – 7% MA, 8% of total North Shore UI Claimants
 - Includes sub-sectors such as: Repair & Maintenance, Laundry Services, Religious, Grantmaking, Civic, Professional, and Similar Organizations, and Private Households

¹ Includes: Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting, Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction, Utilities, Wholesale Trade, Information, Real Estate and Rental and Leasing, Management of Companies and Enterprises, Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation, Other Services, Public Administration
