





Labor Force Participation



- The current rate of 64.9% is 4.9% higher than the COVID rate of 60%.
- November labor force participation rate has declined about 0.5% the past three years.

Updates: Offshore Wind Grant Update

- Contract in place with Massachusetts Clean Energy Center (MACEC)
- Interviewing for Training Manager position (consultant on board to help us with grant startup details and logistics)
 - ➤ A special thank-you to the Salem Planning Department, ECCF, the UMass Amherst Gloucester Marine Station, and SAFE all are active in the startup of the grant.
- Our next steps: work with Essex Tech on implementing the preapprenticeship program, recruitment, etc.

Healthcare Hub Grants

Two new Healthcare grants will be coming to the Northeast in January of 2024:

- (1) Healthcare HUB NorthShore WB Lead
 - Grant will fund training within the general healthcare industry, e.g., CNA/MA positions with a pathway to nursing, various certificate programs, supervisor training, etc.
- (2) Behavioral Health HUB Greater Lowell WB Lead
 - Grant will fund Behavioral Health training, such as community health workers, recovery coaches, specific skill training in de-escalation, etc.

Current ITAs

Results of increased maximum payments (from \$5000 to \$8000 per eligible customer)


- On target to have over 125 ITAs: last year we had only 88 ITAs all year
